UNIFORM POLICY

ALL CLOTHING UNIFORM ITEMS ARE TO BE PURCHASED FROM THE SCHOOL UNIFORM SUPPLIER

PREP - Worn 5 days a week

Summer

- School polo shirt SHORT SLEEVES ONLY
- Blue unisex shorts
- Red ankle socks
- Black Closed-in joggers (velcro fasteners) NO buckles or Mary Jane shoes
- Broad brimmed blue school hat

Winter

- Same as for summer
- Red Polar Fleece Jacket
- Royal Blue Fleece Track Pants
- These will be worn over the polo shirt and shorts as needed.

YEAR 1 to 6 - Worn 2 days a week (Mon & Wed)

Summer

- School polo shirt SHORT SLEEVES ONLY
- Blue unisex shorts
- Red ankle socks
- Black closed-in joggers NO buckles or Mary Jane shoes
- Broad brimmed blue school hat

Winter

- Same as for summer
- Red Polar Fleece Jacket
- Royal Blue Fleece Track Pants
- These will be worn over the polo shirt and shorts as needed.

YEAR 1 to 6 - Worn 3 days a week (Tues, Thurs & Fri)

Summer

- Red Overshirt (Separate boys and girls design)
- Girls Navy Blue Culottes
- Boys Navy Cargo Shorts
- Red ankle socks
- Black closed-in joggers NO buckles or Mary Jane shoes
- · Broad brimmed blue school hat

Winter

- Same as for summer
- Red Polar Fleece Jacket
- Royal Blue Fleece Track Pants (These will be worn over the shirt and shorts as needed)

Uniform Regulations

- Religious medals and crosses may be worn. No other jewellery is to be worn with the school uniform except for watches and plain studs or small sleepers in pierced ears.
- No nail polish is to be worn with the school uniform.
- Shoulder length or longer hair is to be neatly tied back.
- Any additional headwear (e.g. headbands, ribbons, scrunchies) must be in school colours red, blue, yellow and/or white. The school office has a range of compliant headbands for sale.
- During all outdoor activities regulation school hats are to be worn. Children will not be allowed to play outdoors if they do not wear their school hat.
- Children essentially need one pair of shoes and that is sensible, lace-up or velcro ALL BLACK joggers or ALL BLACK sandshoes. These shoes can be worn for the five school days. NO buckled shoes or Mary-Jane style shoes are allowed.
- The Red school bag with logo is compulsory.
- If a child is not in full, correct uniform, parents are asked to notify the child's teacher or the Principal as to the reason by note, by telephone or in person.

If communication is not received by a parent or guardian, the child will have time out of play with a supervising staff member reviewing the uniform policy.
